



February 2023 President's Report

Your parish council met in January as there were a number of outstanding items that needed to be addressed. Below is a summary of the most relevant.

Preparations are in place for our AGM. With so many changes over the years due to the Covid crisis your Parish Council continues to look for ways to ensure the financial viability of our church. We have developed a number of presentations

for the AGM, which will give you a good understanding of how we are doing as an organization. We encourage all of our faithful to attend the AGM and ask questions so that everyone is comfortable knowing the reasons for decisions that are being made.

We will have Larry Balion giving an update on consistory matters and be available for questions from interested individuals.

A decision was made to organize a Pushchenya. It has been many years since we have had one in our church hall. We have put together a good event package and look forward to having a large number of people join us on February 18th.

It has been determined that there is a lack of sufficient insulation in the manse. Discussion centered on what would be in the best interests of our church community regarding the manse. It was just a preliminary discussion, which centred on cash flow from rental of the manse. Expect more discussion in the future.

At the conclusion of the AGM there will be a number of changes to the current Parish Council. One of those changes being that after eight years as parish President I will not be in that role for the 2023 year. While consistency is certainly an attribute it is important for new voices to be involved in the church. I stayed on longer than anticipated due to the Covid crisis but now that we are on a steady course it is time to get back to a more natural cycle and introduce a new President. It has certainly been an honour to be part of the team and I would like to thank everyone who has assisted me over all these years. We have a dynamic, committed and smart Parish Council and it has been such a pleasure to work with them over all these years. For those of you who have the slightest interest in helping out our church please consider in the future becoming a part of YOUR Parish Council. It really is important work.

All the best to the new Parish Council in the coming year. I look forward to working in a different role with the current members and the newly elected members.

Sundays of Lent

Each of the Sundays of Great Lent possesses special meaning for us as we journey through the Lenten season to Pascha, the Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Through our awareness of these days and our participation in the liturgical services of the season, we are instructed and inspired to continue our journey with Christ to the Cross, and ultimately to victory over sin and death

Four Sundays before Great Lent

1. Sunday of the Tax Collector(Publican) and Pharisee

Feb 5



Repentance is the door through which we enter Lent, the starting-point of the journey to Pascha (Easter). To repent signifies far more than self-pity or futile regret over things done in the past. To repent is to be renewed, to be transformed in our inward viewpoint, to attain a fresh way of looking at our relationship with God and with others. in which we are exhorted to true repentance and encouraged to follow the self-abasement of the Publican rather than the spiritual pride of the Pharisee.

2. Sunday of the Prodigal Son (from the Parable)

Feb 12



We are reminded reminded that not only must we repent and undergo a change of heart, but that we must also exercise an act of will, in that we must get up and actually set off on our journey. In our own lives we can see a parallel; for how often do we repeat the cycle of the Prodigal son willful departure from God's house, a life of wantonness, misery at our fallen state, repentance, return to god the Father and divine forgiveness?

3. Sunday of Meat (the Final Judgment)

Feb 19



The next Sunday of Preparation, Meatfare Sunday, is the last day on which meat is permitted to be consumed until Holy Pascha. Otherwise, during the course of this week, on each day, all other animal products (including milk, cheese, eggs, butter, as well as fish) may be consumed. This is to remind us of the upcoming rigors of the Great Fast. The theme of this Sunday is the Last Judgment and the lot of those who turn from God, and those who return to Him.

4. Sunday of Cheese (Adam's expulsion from Paradise)

Feb 26



The important theme is the Expulsion of Adam from Paradise and that forgiveness, since we cannot even begin our spiritual journey without granting forgiveness to those who have offended us and asking forgiveness of those whom we have offended.

The Sundays of the Great Lent are:

1. First Sunday (Sunday of Orthodoxy)

Mar 5



The First Sunday of Great Lent is dedicated to the final triumph of the Church over the iconoclasts and the restoration of the Holy Icons to the churches, which took place on the First Sunday of Lent, March 11, 843.

2. Second Sunday (St. Gregory Palamas)

Mar 12



The Second Sunday of Lent is the commemoration of Saint Gregory Palamas. It was Saint Gregory (d.1359) who bore living witness that men can become divine through the grace of God in the Holy Spirit; and that even in this life, by prayer and fasting, human beings can become participants of the uncreated light of God's divine glory. Also, the theme of this Sunday is that of the Prodigal Son as a model of repentance.

3. Third Sunday (Adoration of Cross)

Mar 19



The Third Sunday of Great Lent is dedicated to the Cross and the bringing-out of the Precious Cross, which closely parallels the ceremonies of the Feast of the Exaltation of the Cross on Sept. 14. At this time, we are reminded of the upcoming crucifixion of the Lord and strengthened to persevere in our Lenten struggles.

4. Fourth Sunday (St. John of Climacus of the Ladder)

Mar 26



The Fourth Sunday is dedicated to St. John Climacus (of The Ladder), Abbot of Sinai, who, because of his ascetical writing (The Ladder) serves as a model of a true Christian ascetic. St John encourages the faithful in their efforts for, according to the Lord, only "he who endures to the end will be saved" (Mt 24.13).

5. Fifth Sunday (St. Mary of Egypt)

Apr 2



The Fifth Sunday of Great Lent is dedicated to St. Mary of Egypt. St. Mary was a harlot living in the Egyptian city of Alexandria who later repented and lived the rest of her life in solitude in the Egyptian desert, serving as a model of repentance to all Christians..

6. Palm Sunday through Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday

Apr 9



Immediately after the end of the forty days of penitence & before the days of darkness and mourning of Passion Week, the Holy Church celebrates the bright festivals of Lazarus Saturday and Palm Sunday. Lazarus Saturday commemorates the raising of Lazarus from the dead and serves as a reminder that Jesus is the Master of life and death and foreshadows the Lord's glorious Resurrection eight days later. Palm Sunday, of course, commemorates Our Lord's glorious entrance into

Jerusalem. On this day Palm/pussy-willow branches are blessed and held by the faithful.

Fasting Піст Ргауег Молитва Аlms

Великий Піст

Протягом століть Свята Православна Церква дотримується практики сорокаденного посту, який Ісус Сам встановив після Його хрещення в річці Йордані на початку Своєї місії. Євангеліє від Матвія вчить, що диявол спокушував Ісуса в пустелі, обіцяючи всякі різні богатства, яких Христос відкинив. Зве ртаємо увагу на те, що вперше спокусив Господа їжею, бо був Він голодний. Господь сказав у відповідь, "не хлібом єдиним житиме людина"

(Мт 4: 4), це знаход ить свій відгук напротязі століть у святих, які попереджають, що обжирство — це двері які ведуть до інших спокус, більших гріхів — гордості, скупості і жадоби в лади. З цієї причини обмеження в їжі під час посту допоможе нам побороти багато спокус.

Свята Православна Церква дала нам можливість для тихого самоаналізу, щоб оцінити пріоритети в нашому житті і сягати до духовного зростання у Христі. Вступаючи на цю постову подорож, це нагода і для нашого оновлення як православні християни. У Хрещенні ми зобов'язалися ділитися з іншими Доброю Новиною Христа, захищати Святу Православну віру від переслідувань, і виявити Христову любов супроти близьких. Дотримуватися справжнього посту означає терпляче іти по цій прямій і вузькій дорозі у боротбі з гріхом. Ця шеститижнева подорож, що ми почали тягне за собою прагнення до смиренності перед Богом в нашому покаянні, шукаючи взаємного прощення роздумуючи над своїм оновленням через молитву. Тож відкриймо наші серця, щоб в них вселилося те, що вічне, те, що Істинне Правда, а не будьмо засліпленими оточуючим нас цим світом. Там, де світло, там — надія. Через Його життя і страждання зара ди нашого спасіння, ми отримуємо нову надію в світлі славної перемоги Христа над смертю і у вічному житті.

Поради оптинських старців християнам, які живуть у світі Поради преподобного Варсонофія (Плеханкова):

"Мені доводиться чути скарги на те, що ми переживаємо тепер важкі часи, що тепер дана повна свобода всяким єретичним та безбожним вченням, що Церква зі всіх сторін піддається нападам ворогів і страшно стає за неї, що здолають її ці мутні хвилі зневіри і єресей. Я завжди відповідаю: 'Не тривожтеся! За Церкву не бійтеся! Вона не загине: ворота адові не здолають її аж до Страшного суду. За неї не бійтеся, а от за себе боятися треба, і правда, що на ш час дуже важкий. Чому? Та тому, що тепер особливо легко відпасти від Христа, а тоді загибел."

Preparing for

For centuries, the Holy Orthodox fast that Jesus Himself instituted after beginning of His mission. The Gospel Jesus in the desert, promising all kinds of Church has followed the practice the forty-day His baptism in the River Jordan at the of Matthew teaches that the devil tempted riches, which Christ rejected. We are talking

attention to the fact that he first tempted the Lord with food because He was hungry. The Lord said in response, "man shall not live by bread alone" (Mt 4:4), this finds its echo throughout the centuries in the saints who warn that gluttony is a door that leads to other temptations, greater sins - pride, avarice and cravings are in order. For this reason, limiting food during fasting will help us to overcome many temptations.

The Holy Orthodox Church has provided us with an opportunity for quiet introspection to evaluate the priorities in our life and to strive for spiritual growth in Christ. As we embark upon this Lenten journey, it is also a time to renew ourselves as Orthodox Christians. Upon baptism we assumed the obligation of sharing the *Good News* of Christ with others, of defending the Holy Orthodox faith from persecution and of living a Christ-centred life of love for others. Keeping the true fast means struggling along such a straight and narrow road. This six-week voyage that we have begun entails striving for humility and contrition before God in our repentance, seeking mutual forgiveness and contemplating our renewal in our prayers. Let us open our hearts to let in that which is eternal, that which is Truth and not be blinded by the temporal world around us. Where there is light there is hope. Through His life and suffering for our salvation, we gain renewed hope in the light of Christ's glorious victory over death and in eternal life.

Advice of Optina elder to Christians living in the world, Saint Varsonofius (Plekhankov):

"I have to hear complaints that we are now going through difficult times, that now full freedom is given to all heretical and godless teachings, that the Church is being attacked from all sides by enemies and it is becoming scary for her that these cloudy waves of disbelief and heresies will overcome her. I always answer: 'Don't worry! Do not be afraid for the Church! She will not perish: the gates of hell will not overcome her until the Last Judgment. Do not be afraid for her, but you must be afraid for yourself, and it is true that our time is very difficult. Why? But because now it is especially easy to fall away from Christ, and then - destruction.' "
