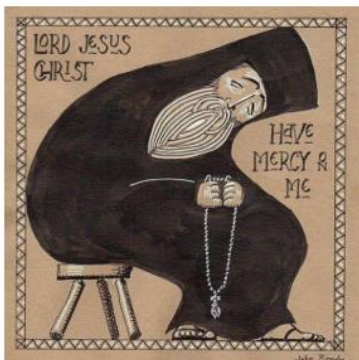

Chotky or the prayer rope is used to focus one's thoughts on the **"Jesus Prayer"** or **"Prayer of the Heart"**. When not in use the chotky can be wrapped around the left wrist like a bracelet, never as a decoration, but as a reminder to pray without ceasing.

The Jesus Prayer

The Jesus prayer preserves the power of silence in prayer. Learning to be silent is far more difficult and far more important than learning to recite prayers. Silence is not the absence of noise but the gift or skill to discern between quiet and stillness. The power to learn to listen, and the wisdom of knowing how. Silence is being fully involved and active. When we pray silently we are able to focus on the heart all that matters. We become more aware of that which matters. Our focus is much more clearer, our prayers become more intent, more meaningful.

THE ASCENSION

When Mary Magdalene stood weeping beside the empty tomb, she showed, as St. John Chrysostom says, the enduring love which she felt for Jesus. Her patience was rewarded. She was the first to see Him risen from the dead. She knew Him only when He said her name. Jesus told Mary to go to the disciples and say:

“I am ascending to My Father and to your Father, to My God and to your God” (John 20:17).

Jesus appeared to the disciples on a number of occasions before He took them out to the Mount of Olives where He blessed them and commanded them to be His witnesses, first in Jerusalem, then, in “all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth” (Acts 1:8).

Jesus was lifted up and a cloud took Him out of their sight. The two men in white robes told the disciples not to keep gazing up into heaven, after the Jesus they loved, because Jesus would return in the same way as they had seen Him leave.

The Ascension was the final Resurrection appearance to the Disciples and Mary, the Mother of God, and it marked a new beginning in all their lives. The Disciples went back to Jerusalem “with great joy” and “devoted themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary, the Mother of Jesus.”

The Disciples elected Matthias to bring their number up to twelve again. They were waiting, as Jesus had told them to; they were waiting for the coming of the Holy Spirit. Jesus had told the Disciples that the Comforter, the Holy Spirit, would not come until He ascended to His Father (John 16:7).

Jesus left us with many promises, three of which are associated with the Feast of the Ascension:

1. Jesus promises to send the Holy Spirit.
2. Jesus promises to remain with us even to the end of time.
3. Jesus promises to return in glory at the second coming.

For Jesus is our forerunner into heaven, He takes our human nature into the Godhead, in His steadfast love.



The Precious Pearl



"The enjoyment of this present life, though it seems to give delight and sweetness, is well thrust from us. At the very moment of its being it ceases to be, and for our joy repays us with sorrow sevenfold. Its happiness and its sorrow more frail than a shadow, and, like the traces of a ship passing over the sea, or a bird flying through the air, quickly disappear. But the hope of the life to come which the Christians preach is

certain and quite sure; howbeit in this world it has tribulation, whereas our pleasures now are short-lived, and in the beyond they only win us correction and everlasting punishment without release. For the pleasures of life are temporary, but its pain eternal; while the Christians labors are temporary but their pleasure and gain immortal. Therefore, right it is to exchange the corruptible for the incorruptible."

St George the Great Martyr and Victor Травня - 6 - May

St George lived in the year 300 AD. He was a clever and intelligent man. While still very young he became a commanding officer of over a thousand warriors. The Emperor Diocletian held this young commanding officer in high esteem.

When Diocletian began his persecution of Christians, George had to face the question of whom to obey –the Heavenly King or the earthly King. George, without hesitation, chose to obey the Heavenly King.

Diocletian tried to turn George against Christ. He tried to threaten George with the loss of his career and the dismal future that he would have to face. None of these threats helped. Diocletian became furious. How dare a commanding officer not obey an Emperor! What an example he was setting for the warriors!

Diocletian became determined to break the will of George and force him to his service. He submitted George to terrible torture (that is why he is called St. George the Martyr), but the torturing did not break George's will because the Lord God helped him.

The people were aware that to stand such inhuman tortures was impossible without the help of God. The people were so impressed that they too declared themselves Christians openly. Many warriors declared themselves Christians, as did the wise man Afanasij, and even the wife of Diocletian, the Empress Alexandra.

Diocletian then realized that he had not over-powered George but that George had over-powered him and that if the struggle continued, more people would come to believe in Christ. He, therefore, ordered that George beheaded. He was beheaded in 303 AD.

Though he had been a great warrior for an earthly king, St. George proved himself an even greater warrior for his Heavenly King. Thus, the Church named him St. George the Victor. The immortal remains of St George lie in the city of Lida (near Ramil) in Palestine

Святий Юрій жив коло 300 року по Різдві Христовім. Він був здібний розумний юнак, і тому, хоч він був ще дуже молодий, він уже був тисячонаачальником (полковником), тобто командував 1000 вояків. Римський імператор Діоклетіян дуже високо цинив свого молодого тисячонаачальника.

Коли за часів Діоклетіяна почалося переслідування (гоніння) християн, то перед Юрієм постало питання: Кого слухати? Чи слухати Царя Небесного, чи царя земного тобто імператора Діоклетіяна? І Юрій без вагання вибрав послух Цареві Небесному.

Діоклетіян намагався відвернути Юрія від Христа. Він малював перед Юрієм світлу картину його майбутнього, якщо він виречеться Христа. Яка велика кар'єра його чекає!

Але його переконування не допомогли. Тоді імператор Діоклетіян сильно розлютився, бо тут уже заговорила в ньому амбіція. Як то так – його, всесильного імператора, його власний тисячонаачальник не хоче слухати! Який приклад він дає іншим воїнам!

І ось Діоклетіян вирішив зламати волю Юрія, -- примусити його до послуху . Він віддав Юрія на страшні муки, і тому ми й зовемо Святого Юрія Великомучеником. Але жодні муки не могли зламати Юрія, бо Господь допомагав йому.

Люди бачили цю Божу допомогу, бо вони знали, що Юрій без неї не зміг би перенести цих надлюдських мук. І люди почали проголошувати себе християнами. Тоді ж і мудрець Афанасій також увірував у Христа. Навіть дружина Діоклетіяна, цариця Олександра, стала християнкою.

І Діоклетіян нарешті побачив, що не він перемагає Юрія, а навпаки – Юрій перемагає його. Діоклетіян побачив, що коли мучеництво Юрія триватиме далі, то ще більше людей увірують у Христа. І тому він видав наказ відсікти Юрієві голову. Сталося це 303 року.

Святий Юрій, будши воїном земного царя, показав себе побідоносним воїном Царя Небесного, і тому Церква назвала його Побідоносцем.
