Annual Meeting of the Central Eparchy

The **Central Eparchy Assembly** of the Ukrainian Orthodox Church of Canada was held October 20-22, 2023 in Regina. The Friday gathering was hosted at Selo Gardens and consisted of a Molebin served in the Selo Chapel, followed by a reception in the dining area.

The Saturday Assembly was held in the meeting area in Descent of the Holy Spirit Sobor and was attended by 27 people – Met. Ilarion, 8 priests, and 18 laity. The morning began with an address by His Eminence Metropolitan

Ilarion who stressed the importance of "full participation" in the church with regular confession and communion, and of a need for a positive message to our faithful. He referred to the 2015 Sobor that recommended that the calendar issue be referred to the Council of Bishops, and relayed that this is pastoral issue, not a political issue, that needs to be focused upon how best to serve the people. The Annual General Meeting that ensued reviewed last year's minutes and the current treasurer's report and budget and elected the Central Eparchy members and executive for the coming year. Four members were elected from each of the four deaneries – Yorkton/Regina, Saskatoon/North, Dauphin/Roblin/Brandon, and Winnipeg, West Ontario. The four members from our Saskatoon/North Deanery serving for the next year are Fr. Peter Wasylenko, Fr. Michael Lomaszkiewicz, Sonia Sokyrka and Alicia Klopoushak. The Central Eparchy levy will remain at

\$18. A motion was passed to increase the funding of church camps to \$1500 each. Two other motions focused on planning an educational retreat in 2024 for the youth of our Eparchy, and for planning a meeting of Sunday School teachers.

Fr. Bozyk shared a message centered on Corinthians 1 and 2. He then presented a report from St. Andrew's College -16 students studying in the Faculty of Theology this fall, most by zoom, and 2 priests from Ukraine are studying theology classes in English at the College.

Fr. Charles Baxter presented a report on the following areas of focus of the Consistory office: completed parish databases (allowed us to double insurance); Jennifer Parks in the Consistory office will have ability to help parishes with the CRA filings; in discussion to partner with another Church for health and dental insurance to lower payments; to complete the property and liability insurance sign-up (all need to be part of the group); hire a communications officer; establish the Office of Missions and Education in 2024 and establish a Youth Ministry in 2024; and apply for federal grants for renovations to the Consistory building.

Heroes of their day Pokrova Icon Покрова - The Protection of Our Most Holy Lady, the Theotokos. The icon is written by Oleksandr Klymenko on ammunition boxes sourced from Ukraine in its defense against Russia.

This icon commemorates the Ukrainian Canadian servicemen and servicewomen, who served and sacrificed for Canada during the Second World War – true "Heroes of Their Day".

This commissioned icon will be installed in the Cathedrals of both the Ukrainian Catholic and Ukrainian Orthodox Churches across Canada.

Ukrainian Genocide Holodomor 1932 – 1933

Stalin detested Ukrainians for their nationalism and their fierce determination for self-rule. To prevent a resurgence of Ukrainian nationhood, his goal was to eliminate Ukrainians from the face of the earth. USSR soldiers dug up every bit of food hidden in their dirt floors, killed all the wild animals and birds in the forest so the Ukrainians couldn't eat them and created the worst famine in the world.

Comparing official Soviet census figures of 1932 to those of 1939, Ukraine had a population loss of 7,465,000 in a 7-year post-war period and rebuilding.

Villages picked up their dead friends and family off the roads and carted them off to the cemetery, covered them with snow and when spring came,, they were able to bury them. The remaining dead were shoveled into mass graves by the Russian soldiers. However, this famine was a big secret. No media rushed to admonish this atrocity. No war crimes were commissioned. No history recorded. The genocide is still denied by many. The souls of 10 million Stalin-victims still cry out for justice.

Angels..... Created Long before Humans

Saint John of Damascus tells us: "God is Himself the Maker & Creator of the angels; for He brought them out of nothing into being & created them after His own image. They are an incorporeal race, a sort of spirit or immaterial fire, even as the divine David says that ' His angels are spirits, & His ministers a flame of fire (Ps 103:6).

Angels were among the first part of God's creation. In the Creed we say, "I believe in one God...Maker of heaven & earth, & of all things

visible & invisible. Holy Scripture says, "When the stars were made, all My angels praised Me with a loud voice" (Job 38:7, LXX). The Apostle Paul tells us "By Him all things created that are in heaven, & that are on earth, visible & invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers" (Col 1:16). Heaven that was created in the very beginning according to Genesis (In the beginning God created the heaven & the earth) is generally understood by the Fathers to be an invisible heaven inhabited with powers on High. They believed that God created the angels long before He created the visible world.

Mankind Knew the Angels

Mankind knew about the existence of angels from their first days in Paradise. From Genesis we know that a Cherubim was placed with a flaming sword at the gates of Paradise after Adam & Eve were expelled. Later, Abraham encouraged his servant Nahor telling him that the Lord would send His angel with him to protect him. *(Gen 34:7).* Jacob saw angels during his sleep & while awake.*(Gen 32:1-2).*

In the time of the New Testament an angel informed Zechariah of the conception of the Forerunner & the Virgin Mary the Theotokos of the birth of Jesus. Angels announced the good news to the shepherds at the birth of Jesus & prevented the Magi from returning to Herod. Angles served Jesus after His temptation in the wilderness & appeared to strengthen Him in the Garden of Gethsemane. It was angels who informed the Myrrh bearing Women about His Resurrection. Angels informed the Apostles of His second coming as the time of His ascension into heaven. Angels help the apostles. They freed Peter from prison & instructed Cornelius. They told Paul to appear before Caeser. Angels are the foundation of the revelations given by John in his book of Revelation.

Nature of Angels Angels are active spirits with intelligence, will & knowledge. They serve God to carry out His will & glorify Him. The angels are bodiless & invisible to our physical eyes. They have no worries about the future either, & no fear of death. For, though God created them before man, they are neither aged nor aging, but unchangingly youthful, beautiful & strong. They have no anxiety about their salvation & no struggle for immorality, being already immortal (Luke 20:36). Unlike men, they are not faltering between good & evil, being already good & holy as when God created them. Peter informs us that in their might & power they surpass all earthly governments & authorities (II Peter 2:10-11). But as created beings they have limitations. They do not know the depths of the essence of God (I Cor 2:11). They do not know the future that only God knows (Mark 13:32). They do not fully understand the mystery of the Redemption yet they wish to (I Peter 1:12). They don't know human thoughts (III Kings 8:39). & thy cannot be themselves perform miracles without the will of God Ps 71:19).

Saint John of Damascus. "An angel, then, is an intelligent essence, in perpetual motion, with free will, incorporeal, ministering to God, having obtained by grace an immortal nature. The Creator alone knows the form & limitation of the angelic essence; but all that we can understand is that it is incorporeal & immaterial. For all that is compared with God, Who alone is incomparable, we find to be dense & material. For in reality only the Deity is immaterial & incorporeal."
